Location: Strathmore Mansion located at 5301 Tuckerman Lane, North Bethesda, MD. Free parking in the Grosvenor/Strathmore Metro parking garage on Tuckerman Lane

Eligibility: Presenting teachers must be paid up members of MCMTA and MSMTA. Students through 12th grade of high school playing music of intermediate level or above may enter. Total performance time for each student is limited to 4 minutes. The timing of each piece must be **precise** to facilitate scheduling of recitals. Approximate grade level refers to the student's piano level, not school grade. Entries will be limited to the first 80 students; no more than 5 students per teacher.

Fee: \$10.00 per student. One check made payable to MCMTA representing the total student fees of one teacher must accompany the application form.

Repertoire: Any ragtime, blues or jazz pieces, late 19th c. to present, predominantly American composers. Students may play solo or ensemble music. All requests for particular recital times **MUST** be made on the application form.

Deadline: Application forms must be postmarked by January 24, 2008. Students' names must be **PRINTED CLEARLY**, and the forms must include both the teacher's and student's telephone numbers. Teachers will be notified by telephone as to which recital their performers may expect to attend. Mail application forms to:
