Accompanist

- All students must use the official accompanist.

Fee

- \$30 per movement
- Fee includes one rehearsal
- Students may compete in any or all movements of ALL LEVELS, but may be named performing winner of only one movement
- Winners will pay \$30 to participate in Winners' Concert

**PLEASE READ AND SIGN BELOW INDICATING
ACCEPTANCE OF THE FOLLOWING RULES:**

- √ All movements must be played from memory
- √ A student may be a performing winner or alternate only once at each level.
- √ Winners **MUST** be available for the orchestral rehearsals set by the conductor or the alternate winner will perform.
- √ The decision of the judges is final and subject to neither protest nor question.
- √ Students will be placed in random order for competition and this order will be strictly observed.
- √ An official accompanist will be provided for each movement and rehearsal times will be assigned.
- √ Teachers will be notified of competition times and any cuts in the score.
- √ Contestants, their parents, and teachers must not fraternize among themselves or the judges until the competition is over and the winners have been announced.
- √ Teachers and parents are allowed to attend rehearsals of their student or child only. They may not observe rehearsals of students of other teachers.
- √ Parents are permitted to attend the Competition. If parents wish to videotape their child's performance, they are permitted to do so; however, videotaping of other student performances is prohibited.
