

INFORMATION and RULES for MCMTA 2010-2011 JUNIOR CONCERTO COMPETITION

Repertoire

- Haydn Concerto in G Major, Hob. XIV:13; (Henle edition)

Eligibility

- Any student through 8th grade
- Students must have studied six months with presenting MCMTA teacher who maintains a studio in Montgomery County
- Any student who has won the competition must skip at least one year before participating in the competition again, but only at a higher level than the level where he/she had won.

Accompanist

- All students must use the official accompanist.

Fee

- \$35 per movement – includes one rehearsal
- Winners (or alternates) will pay additional \$50 to participate in Winners' Concert

COMPETITION DATE: Sunday, November 7, 2010

WINNERS' CONCERT (all levels): TBD

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING RULES CAREFULLY:

- √ All movements must be played from memory.
- √ A student may be a performing winner or alternate only once at each level.
- √ Winners **MUST** be available for **ALL** of the orchestral rehearsals set by the conductor as well as the winners' concert, or the alternate winner will perform.
- √ The decision of the judges is final and subject to neither protest nor question. Parents may not approach judges either before or after the competition.
- √ Students will be placed in random order for competition and this order will be strictly observed.
- √ An official accompanist will be provided for each movement and rehearsal times will be assigned.
- √ Teachers will be notified of competition times and any cuts in the score.
- √ Teachers and parents are allowed to attend rehearsals of their student or child only. They may not observe rehearsals of students of other teachers.
- √ Parents are permitted to attend the Competition. Parents may videotape their own child's performance. However, videotaping of other student's performances is prohibited.
- √ Negative discussions about the event procedures or disputes with the chair during MCMTA events are unacceptable.
- √ No teacher is permitted to attend the Competition.
